- (c) if so, whether People's Health Organisation (India) has distributed 4-5 lakh condoms every month in Mumbai; and
- (d) if so, the steps the Government propose to take to meet the demand of the condoms in Maharashtra so that the AIDS control programme is not affected?

November, 1999 : 2,70,000 pcs.
December, 1999 : 90,000 pcs.
March, 2000 : 90,000 pcs.
June, 2000 : 2,70,000 pcs.
July, 2000 : 1,50,000 pcs.
