(a), (b), (c) & (d) SEBI has sent a proposal to the Government for Investor Protection. It includes, inter alia, safeguards against asset stripping, siphoning of funds and provisions to award compensation. It is Government's endeavour to simplify and streamline procedures for redressing grievances of investors. In this context Government constantly reviews relevant Acts, rules and regulations.
