#### Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have provided any financial assistance to the States to launch drive for adult literacy during the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the norms prescribed for this purpose?

### **Answer**

#### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI JAYSINGRAO GAIKWAD PATIL)

- (a): Financial assistance for Adult Education Campaigns is not provided to the State Governments. However, at district level Zilla Saksharata Samities (ZBSs)have been set up for implementing literacy programmes. The ZSS is a registered society, under the chairmanship of District Collector inter-allia consisting of social and educational activists, persons drawn from voluntary agencies and identified district level officials.
- (b): The State-wise break-up of grants released under Adult Education Programme during the last 3 years is given in Annexure.
- (c): The overall ceilings for Total Literacy and Post Literacy Programmes is based on per learner costwhich has since been revised. The details are as follows:-
