(b), (c) and (d): Uncalled for activities including misbehaviour, cheating and attacks on foreign tourists are law and order problems falling within the purview of the States/U.T. Administrations. Complaints from tourists, whenever come to the notice of the Department, are pursued with the concerned authorities.
