(a) to (e) At present there are 21 Government of India Presses, which fall under the Administrative control of Ministry of Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation. The total capital investment made in these Presses is Rs. 3559.40 Lakhs. A statement indicating the State-wise location of these Presses, alongwithinformation relating to number of workers employed; total output of these Presses during last three years; and the classification of these Presses on the basis of form of organization, is given in the Annexure.
