Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government propose to provide funds to State Governments for opening of food processing and training centers in rural areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the number of industries and centers have been opened during the last three years; and
- (c) the quantum of amount sanctioned during each of the last three years, State-wise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRITH. CHAOBA SINGH)

- (a) & (b): Under the scheme for setting up of food processing and training centers, grant-in-aid is admissible to central or State Government Organizations, educational institutions, NGOs and cooperatives provided the implementing agency is willing to make available the required accommodation, person power and other infrastructural facilities. Assistance up to Rs. 2.00 lakhs for equipments and Rs. 1.00 lakh for raw-material is admissible for a single product line FPTC. For multi product line FPTC themaximum assistance admissible is Rs. 7.50 lakhs for equipments and Rs. 2.00 lakhs for raw-material. A total number of 94 centres have been assisted during the last 3 years as per details at Annexure-I.
- (c): The quantum of assistance sanctioned State-wise during the last 3 year is as enclosed in Annexure-II.
