## Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have formulated any special scheme for the promotion of Hindi in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details of the programmes taken up thereunder during the last three years, year-wise;
- (c) whether the Government encourage the establishment of Hindi medium schools and colleges in the States; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI JAYSINGRAO GAIKWAD PATIL)

- (a) & (b): The Government of India implements the following major schemes for the promotion of Hindi in all the Non-Hindi speaking States including Andhra Pradesh:
- (i) Appointment and Training of Hindi Teachers in Non-Hindi speaking States/Union Territories.
- (ii) Teaching of Hindi through correspondence courses.
- (iii) Schemes of Awards to the writers of Hindi of Non- Hindi speaking States.
- (iv) Scheme of organising work shops to train neo Hindi writers in the Non-Hindi speaking States.
- (v) Scheme of financial assistance to voluntary organisations in the Non-Hindi speaking States for publications and purchase of books in Hindi.

Figures for three years, 1997-98, 1998-99 and 1999-2000 of schemes/awards/workshops etc. in the State of Andhra Pradesh are annexed.

(c) & (d): Schools and Colleges are generally established by State Governments/private managements keeping in view the need for schools and higher education in the particular area and the infrastructural facilities available.
