- (a) The scheme of Operation Blackboard was launched in all states/Uts in 1987-88 including Orissa.
- (b) Since its inception in Orissa, 34,176 i.e. all targeted primary schools have been released funds for teaching learning equipment and 14,112 posts of additional teachers have been sanctioned in single teacher primary schools. 5258 posts of third teacher have also been sanctioned for primary schools where enrolment exceeds 100. Similarly, funds have been released for 10023 upper primary schools for teaching learning equipment and 10023 posts of additional teachers have been sanctioned. 5430 additional rooms have been constructed under this scheme.
