a) b) & c) Proposals seeking central assistance of Rs 270.11 lakhs were received, against an allocation of Rs 70 lakhs, from the Rajasthan government during the year 1999-2000, under the centrally sponsored scheme, `Development of National Parks and Sanctuaries`. Against this Rs 66.54 lakhs were released for the following sanctuaries:
