- (c) the details of those schemes which have not been given clearance so far indicating their cost and the Centre's contribution therein?

a) b) & c) Proposals seeking central assistance of Rs 270.11 lakhs were received, against an allocation of Rs 70 lakhs, from the Rajasthan government during the year 1999-2000, under the centrally sponsored scheme, 'Development of National Parks and Sanctuaries'. Against this Rs 66.54 lakhs were released for the following sanctuaries:
