Various institutions at the National and State level are engaged in these activities. Private, cooperative and public sector enterprises have been building up infrastructure in the form of milk and milk products processing facilities as per need, in various parts of the country.

(c) - In addition to the State Government Plan Schemes, the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying in Government of India is implementing the following schemes to increase milk production and to improve the status of the dairy industry in the count?.
