- (a) The villages surveyed in Maharashtra during the last three years are : Pahur and Pimpal-Khunta, Bouth in Distt. Yavatmal; Betwad, Distt. Dhule; Telegaon Desharsar, Ghuikhed, Dabha and Yarad, all in Distt. Amaravati; Kamthi, Pardi and Kamptee all in Distt. Nagpur and Mumbai.
