(a) & (b): Government of NCT of Delhi has reported that they have decided to set up `Delhi Social Housing Corporation` under Company's Act, primarily for Low Cost Housing for urban poor. Government of NCT of Delhi has also reported that the proposed Corporation will be a joint-venture company with 49% equity participation by the Delhi Government and the remaining to be raised from financial institutions and public issues.
