UPGRADATION OF SEWERAGE SYSTEM

**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is any proposal to upgrade the sewerage system in Daman;
- (b) if so, whether a proposal to this effect has been pending with the Government; and
- (c) if so, the present status thereof alongwith the action taken/proposed to be taken in this regard?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT ( SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA )

(a): Public Works Department (PWD), Daman & Diu has informed that there is no sewerage system existing under Daman Municipal Council and as such, there is a need to have sewerage system under Daman Municipal Council.

(b)&(c): A project identification report entitled `Daman Underground Sewerage Project` prepared at an estimated cost of Rs.7.95 crores by Gujarat Water Supply & Sewerage Board was received in February, 1997.The same was technically examined in this Ministry. The Development Commissioner, UT Administration of Daman was requested in April'97 to prepare a revised detailed project report (DPR) and submit to this Ministry so that technical clearance could be given.No reply has been received from the UT Administration till date.
