Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the loans sanctioned by National SC/ST Finance and Development Corporatior(NSFDC) and SC and ST beneficiaries covered during each of the years from 1996-97 to 1999-2000;
- (b) the policy adopted for grant of loan;
- (c) whether some of the State Governments find it difficult to provide their share; and
- (d) if so, the steps being considered to overcome the difficulties?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SMT. MANEKA GANDHI)

- (a) The details of loans sanctioned by NSFDC to SC/ST beneficiaries covered duringeach of the years from 1996-97 to 1999-2000 are given in the Annexure.
- (b) Loans are granted through the State Channelising Agencies of States/UTs towhom the available funds are notionally allocated in proportion to their SC/STpopulation. Further 90% of funds so allocated are expected to be utilized for low cost units costing upto Rs. 5 lakhs. The channelising agencies have been advised to ensure sufficient flow of funds to educated unemployed & women amongst other beneficiaries. While sanctioning loans, efforts are made to maintain sectorwise balance so that funds are made available in the sectors of agriculture, industry, transport etc.
- (c) Yes Sir. The following State Corporations are finding it difficult to provide their share under NSFDC Schemes:
- i) Bihar State Tribal Coop Corporation.ii) Haryana Harijan Kalyan Nigam.iii) Lakshadweep Development Corporation.
- (d) The matter is being pursued with the State Government,
