MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA)

(a)to(c): No, Sir. There is no proposal to implement any special scheme for the flood affected small and medium size towns and cities. However, this Ministry is administering the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Integrated Development of Small and Medium Towns (IDSMT). Towns upto population of 5 lakhs are covered under the Scheme and may also include towns and cities affected by floods.
