(a) to (c): The Government of Andhra Pradesh indicated an additional requirement of funds to the tune of Rs.10.00 crores under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Use of Plastics in Agriculture during the year 1999-2000. However, within the funds available under the Scheme, the entire allocation of Rs.12.77 crores allocated to the Government of Andhra Pradesh was released to them during 1999-2000. The State Government has an unspent balance of Rs.7.74 crores as on 1.4.2000 under the Scheme.
