Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI AJIT KUMAR PANJA)

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b): The Foreign Minister of Australia Mr. Alexander Downer had visited India during 21-24 March, 2000. Mr. Downer met the Hon'ble President, Prime Minister, Foreign Minister, and Commerce and Industry Minister. Various bilateral and multilateral issues were discussed.
- (c): The Foreign Minister of Australia had a comprehensive discussion on 23rd March, 2000. Both sides agreed that the countries relations would not be affected only with the Non-Proliferation issue and to restart the security relations being closed after the 1998 Pokhran Tests. Mr. Downer also discussed commerce and Industry issues with Murasoli Maran.
