### Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of food processing industries set up in the country, State-wise;

(b) the total number of industrialists who have given representations for setting up of such industries during the last three years in the country;

(c) whether the Government have any scheme to provide any special incentive for setting up of such food processing industries in the areas abundantly producing related crops; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

# Answer

#### THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI TH. CHAOBA SINGH)

(a): Food Processing Industries are both in the organized and unorganized sectors, hence the information on the number of food processing units state-wise is not maintained centrally. However, as per annual survey of industries 1997-98, there were 31415 food processing units in the factory sector. State-wise details are at Annexure-I.

(b): State-wise details of assistance provided by Department of Food Processing Industries for setting up of food processing units during 1997-98, 1998-99 and 1999-2000 is at Annexure –II.

(c) & (d): The Department under its Plan Schemes provides financial assistance in the form of loan or grant- in-aid for setting up/expansion/modernization of food processing industries. Higher financial assistance is provided for setting up of food processing industries in difficult areas such as Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Sikkim, North-Eastern states, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, and Integrated Tribal Development Project (ITDP) areas.
