(a)&(b): The Government propose to recast Urban Poverty Alleviation Programme of Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rojgar Yojana (SJSRY) of which Urban Wage Employment Programme (UWEP) is a component, by the way of revising the guidelines of SJSRY. For this purpose a Core Group under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (UEPA) has been constituted with the representatives of the Planning Commission and representatives of some State Governments.

(c): A statement indicating State-wise and year-wise details of mandays generated under Urban Wage Employment is laid on the Table of the Sabha.
