- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard till date?

(a)&(b): There are no Central schemes for provision of housing. Housing is in the State sector and the State Governments are responsible for formulating and implementing various Housing programmes for the people including Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. The National Housing and Habitat Policy 1998 has laid emphasis on the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

(c)to(e): Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment have circulated certain recommendations of the Drafting Committee. One of the recommendations pertains to formulation of a separate Awas Vikas Yojana for Secheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes with an objective to cover all the houseless among them within a period of 5 years. Housing being a State subject the recommendations will be communicated to all State Governments.
