(c) whether the Committee comprising the secretaries of Labour, Expenditure and Public Enterprise Departments for the purpose, has submitted its report;

(d) if so, the details in this regard; and

(e) the reaction of the Government thereto?

(a) to (e) : In regard to PSUs which are financially weak, government have been providing non-plan assistance to defray, inter-alia, the outgo on payment of wages and salaries to workers. Government have constituted a Group of Ministers (GOM) to examine, inter-alia, proposals for:

(i) Amendment to the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947,

(ii) New Legislation for Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service of Contract Labour in India and to make recommendations in respect of problems relating to payment of wages, salaries and statutory dues of employees of CPSUs, particularly the sick CPSUs.

A Standing Committee of Secretaries (COS) has been constituted to service the GOM. This Committee held its first meeting or 14.2.2000. The recommendations of the COS are to be submitted to the GOM.
