Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Integrated Development of Small and Medium Town Scheme (IDSMT), aproject costing Rs.797 lakhs has been approved during 1995-96 for Warrangal town of Andhra Pradesh. The project comprises 13 schemes of which eight are commercial schemes, two are roads schemes and one each is for street lighting parking and storm water drain. Against the maximum eligible Central assistance of Rs.270.00 lakhs, so far Rs.180.00 lakhs have been released to the town in two instalments. The instalment of central assistance will be considered after receiving the utilisation certificate from the State Government showing atleast 70% utilisation of Central assistance and matching State share taken together.
