(a),(b) & (c): Central Government do not set up sugar mills in the country. The sugar industry has been delicensed with effect from 11.9.98. The entrepreneurs are free to set up sugar mills as per techno-economic viability of their project maintaining a distance of 15 Kms. from the existing sugar factories.
