STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) & (b) OF THE LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 936 ANSWER ON 24TH NOVEMBER 2000 REGARDING EXPORT OF RUBBER.

The export of natural rubber is free under the EXIM Policy (1997-2002). Besides, the Rubber Board has been encouraging export of natural rubber through various promotional measures.

In addition to the ongoing efforts to boost the export of rubber products, a number of steps like continuing interaction with the trade & industry to identify and deal with problems related to exports, extension of Marketing Development Assistance to the exporting community for participation in trade fairs/ exhibitions and organization of buyer-seller meets and other market promotion activities, are being taken.
