- (b) if so, the reasons therefor?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (  $\S$  SRIEENIVASA PRASAD )

- (a) Import of sugar is on Open General License (OGL) since March, 1994. Being an OGL item of import, the individual traders or the corporate entities, whether in the private or public sector, are free to import sugar from any country, including Pakistan, based on their best commercial judgement. There is no agreement with Pakistan for import of sugar.
