THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV)

(a), (b), (c) and (d): In accordance with existing guidelines on domestic air transport service sector, 100% Non-resident Indian (NRI)/ Overseas Corporate Body (OCB) equity and 40% foreign investment is permissible. However, equity participation by foreign airlines is prohibited, both directly as well as indirectly.
