(a) Rajasthan Atomic Power Station Unit-1,2,3 & 4 arepresently in operation in Rajasthan. RAPS-1 is undershutdown since 26.9.2000 for carrying out In-service Inspection (ISI) of coolant channels and end-shields.

(b) & (c) Unit 5 & 6 of Rajasthan Atomic Power Project areplanned to be commenced during the 10th Plan period subject to approvals and availability of financial resources.
