THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (CH. VIDYASAGAR RAO)

(a)to(c): There is no proposal to give monthly pension to the dependents/widows of the persons killed in the terrorists attacks in J&K. The next-of-kins of those killed by terrorists in J&K are paid Rs.1 lakh as ex-gratia relief which is reimbursed to the State Government by the Central Government.
