Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of head constables in Delhi Police who took voluntary retirement during the last three years;
- (b) whether the Government had received complaints of bigamy against some of the head constables in violation of the Hindu Marriage Act;
- (c) if so, the reasons for granting voluntary retirement to these officials despite writing complaints of bigamy against them;
- (d) whether the Government propose to take action against the guilty officials who were responsible for this anomaly;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) & (b): 59 Head Constables in Delhi Polices voluntarily retired during the last three years, of whom the complaint relating to bigamy was received against one Head Constable.
