- (a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha. STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF STARREDESTION NO.192 TO BE ANSWERED ON THE 8TH MARCH, 2000 IN THE LOK SABHA.
- (a): Based on normative requirements of foodgrains, as recommended by National Institute of Nutrition, Hyderabad, and projections of average population as on 1st July, 1997, 1998 & 1999, the States, deficient in foodgrain production, are Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Goa, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Orissa, Tamil Nadu, Tripura & West Bengal.
- (b) to (d): No, Sir. For increasing the productivity and production of foodgrains in the country, however, Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Integrated Cereals Development Programmein Rice/Wheat/Coarse Cereals Based Cropping Systems Areas arebeing implemented. For increasing the production and productivity of Pulses, the Government is also implementing National Pulses Development Project. Under these programmes, incentives are being provided to the farmers on distribution of seeds, improved farm implements and sprinkler sets etc. Under the scheme of ICDP-Rice, incentives on Power Tillers is also being provided. Besides above, field demonstrations and farmers' trainings are also being organised under the above mentioned schemes to acquaint the farmers with the latest production technologies. The State of Kerala is covered underICDP-Rice and National Pulses Development Project.
