VACANT POSTS OF TECHERS IN ENGINEERING COLLEGES OF UP AND BIHAR

**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the posts of teachers are lying vacant in the Engineering Colleges of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar;
- (b) if so, from when these posts are lying vacant and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the time by which these posts are likely to be filled up?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SYED SHAHNAWAZ HUSSAIN)

(a) to (c) : There is a general shortage of teachers in the Engineering Colleges across the Country, filling up of which is a dynamic and continuous process. Engineering colleges in Uttar Pradesh and Bihar are also facing shortage of teachers. Appointments in State Government colleges are made, according to the State Government procedure. In Centrally funded institutes and self-financing colleges, the recruitment of teachers is made as per the recruitment rules of the respective institute. Minute details of vacancy position in each college is not maintained by the Ministry.
