Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the localiser of Indira Gandhi International Airport Cat-II landing system went off the air on January 5, 2000;
(b) if so, the reasons therefor;
(c) the number of flights diverted to runway No. 10 at that time;
(d) whether some foreign pilots have strong objections for landing on this runway; and
(e) if so, the reaction of the Government thereon?
Answer
THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV) (a) & (b):- Yes, Sir. The localiser was unserviceable between 1105 hours and 1143 hours on 5/1/2000 due to a communication failure of the remote-lines in the critical area of the localiser which resulted in equipment getting shut-down.
(c):- Nine flights were diverted to runway 10 at that time.
(d):- No, Sir.
(e):- Does not arise.
