(a) and (b):- Jaipur Airport has been developed as a 'Model Airport' and is adequately equipped with customs and immigration facilities for handling limited international charter flights. Work of extension of runway from 7500 feet to 9000 feet at a cost of Rs. 24.03 crores is planned which is likely to be completed by December, 2002.
