- (c) the details of Lab tests or other tests done by such agencies or is it just on the basis of the exporters declaration;
- (d) whether the Government are considering some other steps to remedy the inspection procedure so that only genuine Handloom Cotton Made ups earn 5 per cent Drawback; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?
