(a) to (d) Task Force on Infrastructure is seized of the requirement of maintenance of National Highway assets created under National Highways Development Project (NHDP)A number of options are under discussion, e.g. including maintenance in the contract for development projects, having separate long term maintenance contracts, combining maintenance with Construction Contracts, etc. No separate fund is contemplated. Efficacy of these suggestions will be tried out in future contracts.

(e) Government has undertaken the prestigious NHDP project in the country. It is financed from cess fund, market borrowings, external assistance and private sector funding. Modern methods of construction and operation through qualified, well-equipped and financially sound contractors are adopted. The work is supervised by specialist consultants.
