- (b) the total amount of expenditure incurred thereon as on date ;
- (c) the total amount out of the said expenditure reimbursed by the Union Government till date and the time by which the remaining amount is likely to be reimbursed ;
- (d) the details of new proposals pending clearance as on date; and
- (e) the time by which the remaining proposals are likely to be cleared ?

(a) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways. The details in respect of Rajasthan State are given below:
