## Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether due to growing urbanization and growth of townships on both sides of National Highways there is a tremendous increase in the fatal accidents;
- (b) if so, whether the Government propose to construct subways on the National Highways at densely populated townships;
- (c) if so, whether any private investment proposals to construct subways with permission to commercially exploit the land are being considered/pending clearance;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR ROAD TRANSPORTAND HIGHWAYS (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) ( MAJOR GENERAL (RETE KHANDURI, AVSM)

- (a): No data establishing direct correlation between increase in fatal accidents and the growing urbanization is available.
- (b): Proposals for construction of sub-ways across National Highways in urban areas are considered on the basis of pedestrian and vehicular traffic, when required.
