Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan had undertaken an exercise to freeze class-sections of Kendriya Vidyalayas and to group them into six categories in each section from classes I to XII in 1999;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) whether a Baldev Mahajan Committee was set up to advise the Sangathan on this matter in December, 1999;
- (d) if so, whether the Committee had opined against freezing of sections; and
- (e) if so, the validity of freezing them even after July 17, 2000 after acceptance of the recommendations of the said Committee by the Governors of KVS?

Answer

- (a) to (d): Yes, Sir. The Mahajan Committee did not find the freezing of sections in Kendriya Vidyalayas as an academically sound proposition.
- (e) The recommendations of the committee were accepted by the Board of Governors in principle with the decision that Government of India may be requested for providing flexible salary budget to KVS.
