(a), (b) & (c): Available data indicate that reduction in the revenue of the Department of Telecom Services (including MTNL), due to tariff re-balancing, in financial year 1999-2000, is likely to be approximately Rs.2,000 crores. Consequential reduction in Internal Resources for the developmental plan will be made good by increasing the borrowing component.
