Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Indian Air Force propose to set up an integrated air defence system, essentially a nationwide network, that will provide real time air situation picture to military decision makers;

(b) if so, the salient features of the project; and

(c) the time by which it is likely to be acquired?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES)

(a) Yes, Sir. The Government has proposed to acquire five Integrated Air Command and Control Systems(IACCS), forestablishing Integrated Air Defence along the Western and South-Western borders.

(b) An Integrated Air Command and Control System (IACCS) wouldhave the capability to integrate air situation picture, received in real time, from ground-based, as well as, airborne sensors. The integrated air-picture would be available to the IAF commanders to initiate monitor and control tactical air defence actions against any hostile intruders in our air space.

(c) This will be known only when the contract is concluded.
