THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI OMAR ABDULLAH)

(a) to (d): At present, trade with China is taking place through Lipulekh Pass(Uttar Pradesh) and Shipkila Pass (Himachal Pradesh). As regards the road from Calcutta via Guwahati connecting the Still Well road linking Central Myanmar and China, the possibility of opening additional points for border trade has been discussed with the Government of Myanmar. While the Myanmar Government agree in principle to opening of additional border points, they would like to first ensure the smooth functioning of the existing border trade at Moreh-Tamu sector on the Indo-Myanmar border before taking any further decision in this respect.
