(a) whether Dr. Ambedkar Birth Centenary Celebrations Committee, headed by the Prime Minister, recommended for admission of students from SC/ST community to the fullest extent against their quota of seats in the year 1993;

(b) if so, the action taken thereon;

(c) the number of seats offered in different faculties/disciplines in Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun, in Graduation/Post Graduation level courses during each of the last five years; and

(d) the total number of students from SC/ST community admitted to the above referred courses including their percentage as compared to the total seats during the last five years, year-wise?

## Answer

(b) All the concerned Ministries / Authorities have been informed for necessary compliance.

(c)&(d) Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun conducts only Post-graduate course in Wildlife Sciences. The admission to this course is through national test conducted every alternate year. There are 10 seats for Indian students and 2 for overseas students. One seat out of 10 is reserved for SC / ST candidate. The course-wise details are as under:\_
