- (a) whether Maharashtra has cent a proposal seeking additional provision for installation of drip irrigation system during the Ninth Five Year Plan period;

- (d) whether the State Government has asked to provide at least Rs.100 crore per year for this purpose; and

- (a) & (b) The Government of Maharashtra requested for providing Rs.500.00 crores for drip irrigation during the Ninth Plan.
- (c) The central share provided to the Government of Maharashtra during the first threeyears of the Ninth Plan under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Use of Plastics in Agriculture is given below:

- (d) Yes, Sir.
- (e) Based on the budgetary allocations under the Scheme and their performance, the State Government of Maharashtra was provided assistance during the first three years of the Ninth Plan. With effect from the year 2000-01, the programme for drip irrigation has been amalgamated under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Macro Management in AgricultureSupplementation/Complementation of States' Efforts through Work Plans. Accordingly, the State Government was informed to provide adequate funds for drip irrigation in their Work Plan.
