- (a) the number of Low Power Doordarshan Kendras in Jammu and Kashmir not functioning satisfactorily at present;
- (b) the details of the existing range and capacity of these Doordarshan Kendras;
- (c) whether the Government propose to increase the coverage of these Doordarshan Kendras;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, thereasons therefor?

Answer

- (a): All the existing Low Power Tramsmitters in Jammu and Kashmir are reported to be functioning satisfactorily.
- (b): These Low Power Transmitters have a capacity of 100W and primary range of about 15 Kms.
- (c) &(d): With a view to further augment TV coverage in Jammu and Kashmir, Government has already approved a special plan for setting up of the following TV transmitter projects:
- i. 2 HPTs (DD1 & DD2) each at Naushera, Kupwara, Gurez, Tithwaland Samba. ii. One HPT (DD2) at Poonch iii. One HPT (Kashii Channel) at Srinagar. iv. Mobile LPTs at 12 locations and VLPTs at 60 locations. v. Augmentation of existing 11 VLPTs from 2x10W to 2x50W each
- (e): Does not arise.
