- (a) whether the Government have finalized its plans for filling up vacancies for various Low Powered Transmitters (LPTs) in the North-East region, particularly in the State of Nagaland;

- (c) the reasons for delay and the time by which such vacancies are likely to be filled?

(a)(b)&(c):At present 8 posts in various grades are vacant in all the three LPTs installed in the State of Nagaland. However, this minor shortage of staff is not affecting the transmission and all the transmitters are fully operational. It is the endeavour of Prasar Bharati to fill up all the vacant posts at the earliest.
