- (c) the amount spent on these schemes during the last three years alongwith the names of countries which provided assistance and the extent of assistance provided in this regard, year-wise;
- (d) the target fixed for family welfare during the Ninth Five Year Plan; and
- (e) the percentage of target achieved as on date?

Answer

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The list of schemes/projects in which foreign assistance has been received is provided in Statement-I.
- (c) Since many external agencies are supporting more than one project, consolidated statement of assistance received from these during last three years is presented as Statement- II.
- (d) An outlay of Rs. 15120 Crores has been fixed for IX Plan(1997-2002).
- (e) Till October 2000, a sum of Rs. 9043 Crores has been utilised, which is 59.8 percent of the total outlay.
