Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of financial assistance proposed to be provided to Rajasthan during the current year for propagation and spread of education in the State;
- (b) the details of social organisations which propose to set up educational institutions at their own expenditure in the State;
- (c) the details of the proposals lying pending for approval for the last one year; and
- (d) the role of the Union Government in regard to disposal of the proposals of the educational institutions?

Answer

(a) to (d): An amount of Rs. 57.00 Lakh is proposed to be released during the year 2000-2001 to the Resource Centre, Jaipur, Rajasthan, a n NGO working under Rajasthan Adult Education Association. State Government has submitted a proposal under Operation Blackboard Scheme, for release of Rs. 15,84,80,000/- for teaching-learning equipment in 3962 upper primary schools. Further, an amount of Rs. 14.00 crores has been earmarked for release to DPEP Rajasthan. The actual release will depend on progress of expenditure during the year. The Ministry maintains the details of only those non-governmental organisations who are given financial assistance under various schemes.
