(a) whether any high powered official delegation visited Singapore in November, 2000;

(b) if so, the details of issues discussed and the outcome thereof; and

(c) the way visit is likely to foster closer relationship between the two countries?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS(SHRI AJIT KUMAR PANJA)

(a) President Shri K.R.Narayanan paid a state visit to Singapore from November 9-13, 2000.

(b) Our political and economic relations bilaterally and in the regional forum of ASEAN were discussed, with emphasis on promoting Trade, Investment, Culture and Tourism. An MOU on setting up a Task Force on Economic Cooperation; an Executive Programme on Cooperation in the Arts, Heritage, Archives and the Library; and an MOU on the loan of artifacts to the Asian Civilisations Museums, were signed during the visit.

(c) Discussions at the highest level in Singapore and implementation of the three Agreements mentioned above would help in fostering a closer relationship between the two countries.
