(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Instructions were issued in 1987 to all Telecom Circles to hold Telephone Adalats every three months. The Adalats are held at each SSA (Secondary SwitchingArea) Headquarters and are conducted by a three member bench of senior officers presided over by the Head of the SSA/ District.
